### Abstract Guidelines

**Title:** Use **Times New Roman, Bold, 14 pts**; indent left, sentence-type (only initial letter of the first word is capitalized)

Author's names (give full name and surname): Use Times New Roman, 12 pts; underline the name of the presenting author, and put asterisk (\*) at the corresponding author's name

*Institution and mailing address: Use Times New Roman, Italic, 10 pts*

Abstract: A good abstract should contain a brief introductory statement of the research and continue with a summary of the results obtained, followed by a statement of the conclusions. Please use other special characters/symbols for Greek and scientific symbols (for example:  $\alpha$  for alpha,  $\beta$  for beta).

Abstracts should not exceed 300 words, formatted in Microsoft Word, and single-spaced, using Times New Roman font and size 12. The whole abstract must be one paragraph within one A4 page and inside this box. Before submitting your abstract, please check the spelling and do language proof carefully. Your abstract will be published in the abstract book as received.

Keywords: 3-5 words, use Times New Roman, *Italic*, 10 pts; capitalized initial letter for each word; e.g. *Indigenous plants, Vegetables, Antioxidant, Phenolic compounds*.
